HOW TO SUPPORT THE SALLY WALKER BURSARY

All donations go into the capital endowment of the Sally Walker Bursary Fund, and the income is spent by the school to support the bursary pupils.

Gift Aid is reclaimed by the charity from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer.

REGULAR GIFTS

You can choose to make a regular gift by Standing Order. You can make your gift monthly, quarterly or annually. You can instruct your bank to stop the payments at any time.

SINGLE GIFTS

Donations of any amount can be made by cheque or by online transfer.

GIFT AID

If you are paying UK income or capital gains tax the School is able to reclaim 25 pence for every £1 you give. Your address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer.

Gift Aid can be reclaimed as long as you have paid the equivalent amount of tax to the amount being reclaimed. If you pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax in the current tax year than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your donations it is your responsibility to pay any difference.

ANONYMOUS GIFTS

If you indicate that you wish this gift to be anonymous, we understand this to mean that you want us to ensure that knowledge of your gift is kept solely within the School and is only accessible to the bursar. If you have other specific wishes regarding your anonymity, please indicate this to us.
